Dr. Bakshi told the members that students are being asked to submit their statement of purpose online.

Principal expressed the need for data of achiever alumni. It was suggested by all that TICs / retired teaches' association should be contacted for that. Dr. Paliwal was assigned the responsibility.

All the members expressed the need to improve the college website and discussed the modalities. It was decided that college should have a new improved and more informative web site. Chairman Dr. I.S. Bakshi discussed the accreditation report of NAAC committee (survey conducted on 21st and 22nd March 2017). Recommendations of the committee for improvement of college in various aspects were briefed and role of IQAC in helping the college to fulfill the subsequent goals was elaborated by members.

For encouraging the involvement of teachers in curriculum up gradation and syllabi revision, since it is already in practice, teachers be asked to submit their involvement to IQAC along with a documentary proof.

Teachers be asked to maintain a dairy of their academic activities including teaching and research and co-curricular activities. Every teacher is required to put his/her teaching schedule for complete semester on college web site in beginning of each semester. Every teacher is also required to fill a self appraisal Performa and submit it online to college latest by March last week every year.

For job oriented workshops and seminars, departmental societies and individual teachers should be asked to conduct more number of enabling workshops.

For professional and job oriented courses students be made aware of such courses run by various educational bodies like IGNOU.

For evolving a feedback mechanism, Principal said a student feedback Performa will be applicable in college, issue is at governing body level. Dr. Alka Gupa and Dr. Anita Goel suggested putting a student suggestion box in college. Notice of same be put on college website. In addition a student interaction meeting and a meeting with college alumni will be conducted annually by IQAC.

For identifying slow learners and for improving teaching learning process, teachers be asked to take extra classes for them if required, take more number of class tests, keep a record of them and submit the details in self appraisal Performa.

Each department be asked to submit a list of open source software being used by them. For encouraging the further use of open source Software among students, it was suggested by Dr. Alka Gupta that a lecture be organized by IQAC on ICT in higher education and Dr. Anita Goel, member, IQAC kindly agreed to be the resource person for the same.

For maintaining a record of student progression, it was proposed by Dr. Alka Gupta initially a database of contact number and email ids should be created by collecting information from the students when they fill up their examination forms/admission forms. Dr. Arun Pal Singh suggested that after students have passed out from college, their engagements can be recorded in a form will be required to fill when they come to collect their degrees.

College should devise a mechanism for collecting data on dropouts and take relevant steps to help them if required.

For enhancing computerized financial management system in college, the fund allocated to each department/ society/ committee/Any other activity should be communicated online to their conveners/TIC's. They in turn should be asked to submit final utilization certificates online along with a hard copy including related bills to college office.

For replacing the existing lights with LEDs Principal informed the members that efforts are going on.

It was suggested by the Principal that Placement Cell should be asked make more efforts towards improving employability, increasing the number of students placed, inviting more companies offering better salary packages. The placement Cell should also make efforts of signing MOUs with various companies.

Principal suggested that departmental societies should be encouraged to organize more number of seminars and workshops, utilizing their allocated funds rather than spending the same on farewells and freshers' parties. All the members suggested that all the societies should hold their first meeting within one month of their constitution, formalize their plan of action for the complete year and put it on the college website before the start of new academic session and also submit their annual report at end of same academic session.

For training and development programs for non-teaching staff, Principal suggested lectures be organized on issues like how they should interact with students, on gender sensitization. Dr. Alka Gupta suggested a computer training program should be organized which should be mandatory for all.

A research Committee should be constituted and made functional in college.

Departmental libraries should be created out of books donated by the teachers.

College should make an effort to establish a gymnasium in the college

Steps should be taken to constitute parents teacher association in college.

To start 'Earn While Learn" scheme in college, students be asked to give details whether they are earning while they are pursuing their graduation in the college or submit their jobs of preference. This is to enable college to take suitable follow up action.

For collecting student related information, college should get a compulsory Performa filled by them when they come to fill their examination forms.

Principal proposed expansion of IQAC as per revised guidelines by NAAC.
