ABOUT OUR COLLEGE

Dyal Singh College was established in the year 1959 and was affiliated with the University of Delhi in the year 1978. The college campus of over 11 acres is centrally located on the Delhi Metro map at Lodhi Road in South Delhi. The college's origin arose from the estate of Sardar Dyal Singh Majithia, founder of The Tribune and Punjab National Bank, who willed his estate in 1895 for the establishment of an educational trust for a secular college. Consequently, Dyal Singh College was established at Lahore in 1910. After the Partition of India, Dyal Singh College was established in Karnal and Delhi. It started functioning in the capital at Rouse Avenue as a constituent college of the University of Delhi w.e.f. 5th August 1959 and at present location since 16th October 1962. It was taken over by the University of Delhi as a university-maintained institution in 1978 and has been affiliated proudly since then. The college has been accredited 'A' in NAAC and ranks 29th in NIRF.






